What does my camper need to bring to camp?



CLOSED-TOED SHOES

If a camper is **NOT wearing closed-toed shoes,** they will not be allowed to sign-in to camp in the morning. Flip-flops or water shoes may be packed in bags to wear once we arrive at the beach or waterpark.



Balances are due TENDAYS prior to the first day of each camp week

If balances are not paid by the end of the day, ten days prior to each week of camp, registration will be forfeited and we will call the waitlist.

Sign-In & Sign-Out Information

Scamper Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. Campers will be allowed to sign in starting at 8:50a.m. Please park and follow the signs to the Scamper Camp classroom where counselors will be waiting to greet and sign your camper in.

Please DO NOT bring your camper to camp if they are not feeling well.

Sign-Out will be on the small fenced in playground or in cases of inclement weather, from the classroom.

All children must be picked up **NO LATER than 1:00 p.m.** You will have to sign your camper out with their counselor before they can be released. Only authorized adults will be allowed to pick up a camper. If you are not able to pick up your child, please fill out the Consent Pick Up and Release Form. This form can be kept on file all summer and may include anyone allowed to pick up your child.

Change in Routine

It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to notify Scamper Camp staff if your child...

Medication

Scamper Camp staff will not be administering medication to any campers. If your child requires medication during the hours of camp, we require that you administer the medication to your child, or allow your child to administer their own medication under the supervision of the Camp Supervisor, Director or Assistant Director. If your child requires medication, please notify the Camp Director to receive the proper paperwork. Summer camp is NOT a good time for a med vacation! If your child is usually on meds, please continue them for their time at camp, and if possible, do not make changes less than 30 days before camp. There are so many changes and stresses of coming into a new social environment, that chemical changes can really complicate things.

Lunch

- Bring a packed snack, lunch and water bottle everyday
- Lunches will not be refrigerated, please have an icepack or insulated lunchbox
- Please be sure to <u>label</u> all water bottles and lunch boxes
- Please include a snack for your camper
- Sharing of food is not permitted
- Any food allergies or intolerance should be noted on the medical forms sent to camp
- **Ice Cream will be served on Thursdays and Freezer Pops may be served Daily**

Camp T-Shirts

Your camper will be given a Camp T-Shirt the first day of camp.

Camp T-Shirts must be worn on Wednesdays, Field Trip days.

Additional T-Shirts may be purchased for \$10

Field Trips

- ✓ Scamper Camp will be taking a field trip every Wednesday (weather permitting). Campers will be transported via school busses.
- Campers MUST wear their camp shirts on field trips. Each camper will be given a bracelet labeled with the camp name and phone number. If we are on a water field trip, their swim levels you indicated on their paperwork will also be marked on their hands.
- ✓ Headcounts are performed constantly to keep our campers safe.
- ✓ Should any emergencies occur, all staff members are CPR and First Aid certified and always have a first aid kit on hand. Every attempt will be made to notify the parent/guardian or emergency contact if a child is seriously injured.
